Supplier Recording and Auto-Transcription Policy

To protect confidential and sensitive information, Chemours doesn't permit the recording and auto-transcription features in Microsoft Teams including suppliers and third parties. This measure is part of our ongoing commitment to safeguarding proprietary and confidential information and to reduce the risk of unintentional disclosure, in compliance with all applicable data protection regulations.

This policy applies to all suppliers, contractors, consultants, and third parties conducting business with or on behalf of Chemours. Suppliers are not permitted to record meetings involving Chemours employees or Chemours business without explicit authorization from Chemours.

If a supplier believes that recording a meeting is necessary and can demonstrate clear business value, the supplier must first seek approval from their designated Chemours buyer. The buyer will then obtain the necessary authorization from the Chief Chemours Procurement Officer before any meeting involving Chemours personnel or business matters may be recorded.

Adherence to this policy is mandatory. Unauthorized recording or transcribing of meetings is strictly prohibited.
